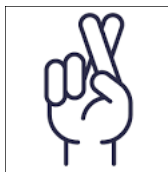

James Whitcomb Riley was born in Greenfield Indiana in 1849 and died the year of Indiana's centennial, 1916. According to the Daily Reporter he performed at the White House for every president from Benjamin Harrison to Woodrow Wilson.
