LifeStream's Fall Fest Returns!


The annual tradition of

Emergency Pull Cord Information

Every apartment here at SVC's has emergency cords, also known as call-for-aid systems, located in the bedroom and the bathroom. For safety reasons it is important that these cords are maintained properly.

The cords need to hang within 6 inches from the floor at all times. This is so that if someone has a fall and cannot stand up


they are able to pull the cord. These cords should NEVER be cut, wrapped around the box or hung up.

Pulling the cord sounds alarms through the hallways of the building that others can hear. There is a light above each door that will flash above the apartment of the person who has sounded the alarm. If staff is here we imme-

diately go check on the resident. When staff is not here it's important for residents to call 911 if you are unable to make contact with the person inside to ensure their safety. There have been incidents in the past where residents have done a wonderful job helping call the police and aiding them in finding the correct apartment.
